 - 2.6. All decisions made by Council throughout the Competition are final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into.

 - e) The decision of the Chief Executive Officer will be given to you in writing,
 - f) At all times during the dispute resolution process, the Chief Executive Officer must act in accordance with the principles of natural justice and fairness.
