I can bring things to help me enjoy the day.



When I arrive, I might see lots of people. I will line up along the fence.





Sometimes friendly entertainers in costumes say hello.





I will show my ticket to staff at the entrance.

The staff wear a yellow vest saying 'Event Staff' or a pink vest saying 'Volunteer' on the back.

They are friendly and I can ask them for help.



When I get inside, there will be a lot of things to see and do.





There will be lots of people and lots of noise.



There are so many fun activities to try such as mural painting, dance, Build a Bee, or a cubby and things to learn.





Sometimes I might have to wait a little bit.

Signs will tell me what time the stage shows begin.









I can watch shows, but there may be things that make me nervous like a lot of people and loud sounds and music.





If I get nervous during the day, I can cover my eyes and ears or put on my headphones.





If I need a break, I can go to the sensory friendly space at the Quiet Zone.



There will be loads of different smells from the family friendly food vans.

I can bring my own water bottle to fill at the Water Monster refill station.





I can use the bins around the venue for all my rubbish.





There are accessible portable toilets around the venue, or I can visit the toilets in the shopping centre.

Toilets are clearly marked with a sign on the outside.

A Child Feed and Change space is available at the event and at the shopping centre.





If I get lost or need help of any kind – such as finding the Quiet Zone, toilets or a fun activity - I can ask the person wearing a yellow vest saying 'Event Staff' or wearing a pink vest saying 'Volunteer' on the back.





When I am finished I will leave through the entrance I arrived, and safely walk to the car park or the shopping centre.
